



Information about our use of cookies

Our Site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Site and also allows us to improve our Site. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. Cookies are typically assigned to one of four categories, depending on their function and intended purpose: absolutely necessary cookies, analytical/performance cookies, functional cookies, and cookies for marketing purposes.

We use the following cookies:

- **Analytical/performance cookies.** These cookies collect information about how you use our Site. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. These cookies don't collect information that personally identifies you and only collect aggregated and anonymous information.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Cookie	Name	Purpose	More information
Analytical/performance cookie	Google Analytics	<p>Google Analytics use persistent cookies to track data.</p> <p>These cookies do not collect any personally identifiable information and are only used for statistical collection of data such as visits and page hits.</p> <p>Google Analytics' cookies store IP addresses but we cannot link those addresses to any individual or path through the website.</p> <p>Google uses the cookies to read information and evaluate visitors' use of the website in the form of statistical reports we can access.</p>	http://www.google.com/intl/en_uk/analytics/
